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**PROCEEDINGS OF THE STATE LEVEL PROJECT MONITORING COMMITTEE
(SLPMC) MEETING ON 06.12.2010 AT 4.00 PM IN THE SECOND FLOOR
CONFERENCE HALL OF THE SECRETARIAT**

The meeting of the State Level Project Monitoring Committee (SLPMC) on Externally Aided Projects (EAPs) was held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary on 06.12.2010 at 4.00 P.M in the Second Floor Conference Hall of the Secretariat to consider the proposals / projects of Works, Water Resources and Fisheries & ARD Departments. The list of participants is given in a statement at **Annexure**.

2. At the outset, Development Commissioner welcomed the Chairperson and the participants and briefly outlined the purpose of the meeting. Chief Secretary requested the concerned Departments to explain the details of their proposals / projects for consideration and approval by the Committee.

3. **Restructuring of the 'Orissa State Roads Project' (OSRP)**
(Works Department)

Engineer-in-Chief-cum-Secretary, Works Department indicated that as per World Bank Loan Agreement, following three roads with a length of 257 Kms have been included for execution for the year- 2 package of Orissa State Roads Project.

i) Taptapani - Raipanka	68 Kms
ii) Raipanka - J.K. Pur	83 Kms
iii) Jagatpur - Chandbali	106 Kms
Total	257 Kms

Of the above three roads, first two roads, i.e., Taptapani - Raipanka (68 Kms) and Raipanka - J.K. Pur (83 Kms) involving a length of 151 Kms have been proposed to be covered under Vijayawada - Ranchi Corridor with the assistance from Government of India. Hence these two roads need to be deleted and as a substitute, a new road namely, Banarpal - Daspalla Road having a length of 80 Kms may be included. After detailed

deliberations, the Committee approved the proposal of Works Department. It was decided that the following two roads with a length of 186 Kms will be executed in the year -2 package of the Orissa State Roads Project instead of 257 Kms proposed earlier.

i) Jagatpur - Chanbali	106 Kms
ii) Banarpal - Daspal	80 Kms
Total	186 Kms

Works Department will initiate further follow up action. EIC-cum-Secretary, Works and Project Director, World Bank Project were requested to take immediate steps to remove the bottlenecks, fix milestones and ensure expeditious execution of the project.

4. Enhancement of the project cost of 'Dam Rehabilitation and Improvement Project - DRIP (Water Resources Department)

Engineer-in-Chief of Water Resources explained that approved project cost of DRIP was Rs.131.00 crore including the base cost of Rs.119.00 crore and contingency of Rs.12.00 crore. As per decision of the World Bank Mission, there will be a price contingency of Rs.16.75 crore. Hence, the project cost will be enhanced from Rs.131.00 crore to 147.75 crore. Both the Finance Department & Planning & Co-ordination Department have concurred in the proposal. After due deliberation, SLPMC approved the cost enhancement proposal of DRIP from Rs. 131.00 crore to 147.75 crore. Water Resources Department will take further follow up action.

5. Capacity Building for Increasing the Fish Production and Improving the Livelihood of Fishermen (Fisheries & ARD Department)

The Commissioner-cum-Secretary, Fisheries & ARD stated that the project will be funded by JICA in the form of Technical Co-operation grant and as already decided the project will have following four objectives

- To make efforts to build the required capacity to fish in deep waters.

- To provide necessary training to fishermen families for hygienic handling, and drying, of fish.
- To develop forward linkages like packaging, and marketing, both in domestic and overseas markets.
- To provide alternative avenues to fishermen within the fishing sector at the time of ban on fishing activity.

Commissioner-cum-Secretary, Fisheries & ARD Department further stated that he had already made a preliminary discussion with the officials of JICA. Some more time will be required for preparation of DPR. It was decided that the Commissioner-cum-Secretary, Fisheries & ARD Department would prepare DPR and present a concept note in the subsequent meeting of SLPMC for its approval.

6. The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
