

S. No.	RFQ Clause Reference	Query	Reply
a)	The Threshold Technical Capacity	Taking DBFOT guidelines of Ministry of Finance, the threshold technical capacity set at Rs. 220 Crores is twice of what is required as per guidelines of NHAI, who are the pioneer in the country today when DBFOT projects are concerned. This project being an Orissa govt. Project and not that of Ministry of Finance, Govt. Of India, taking threshold technical capacity equal to the cost of the project would not only encourage more competition but also enhance the chances of construction companies in Orissa to apply for this project. b)	Eligible Projects under Categories 3 & 4	With rapid infrastructural development happening in the state in last one year only, projects more than Rs. 25 crores were very hard to find until recently. So, payments/receipts up and above Rs. 25 crores should not be considered rather Rs. 10 crores and above considered in the earlier bulletins for RFQ of this project are more relevant in this case.
